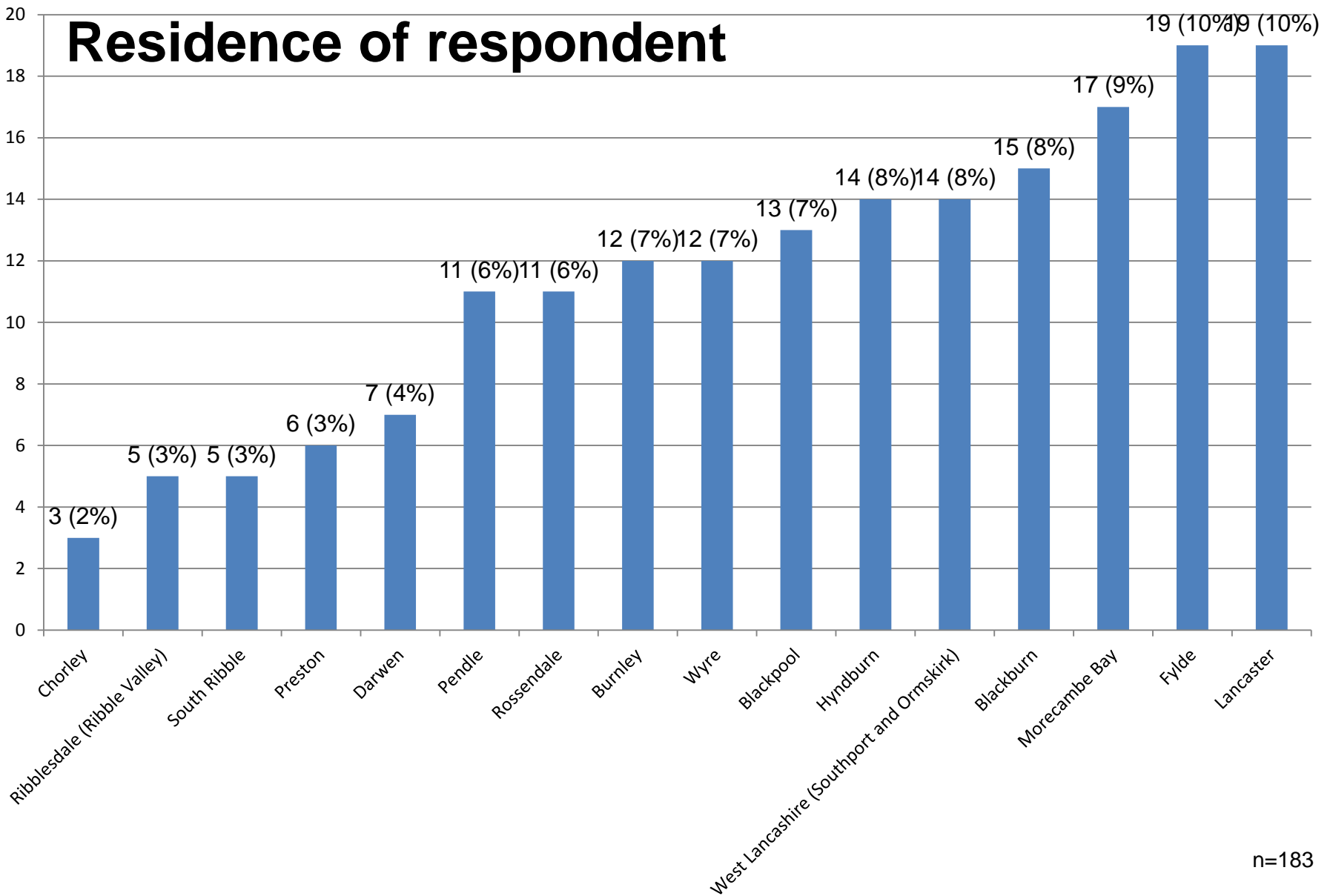

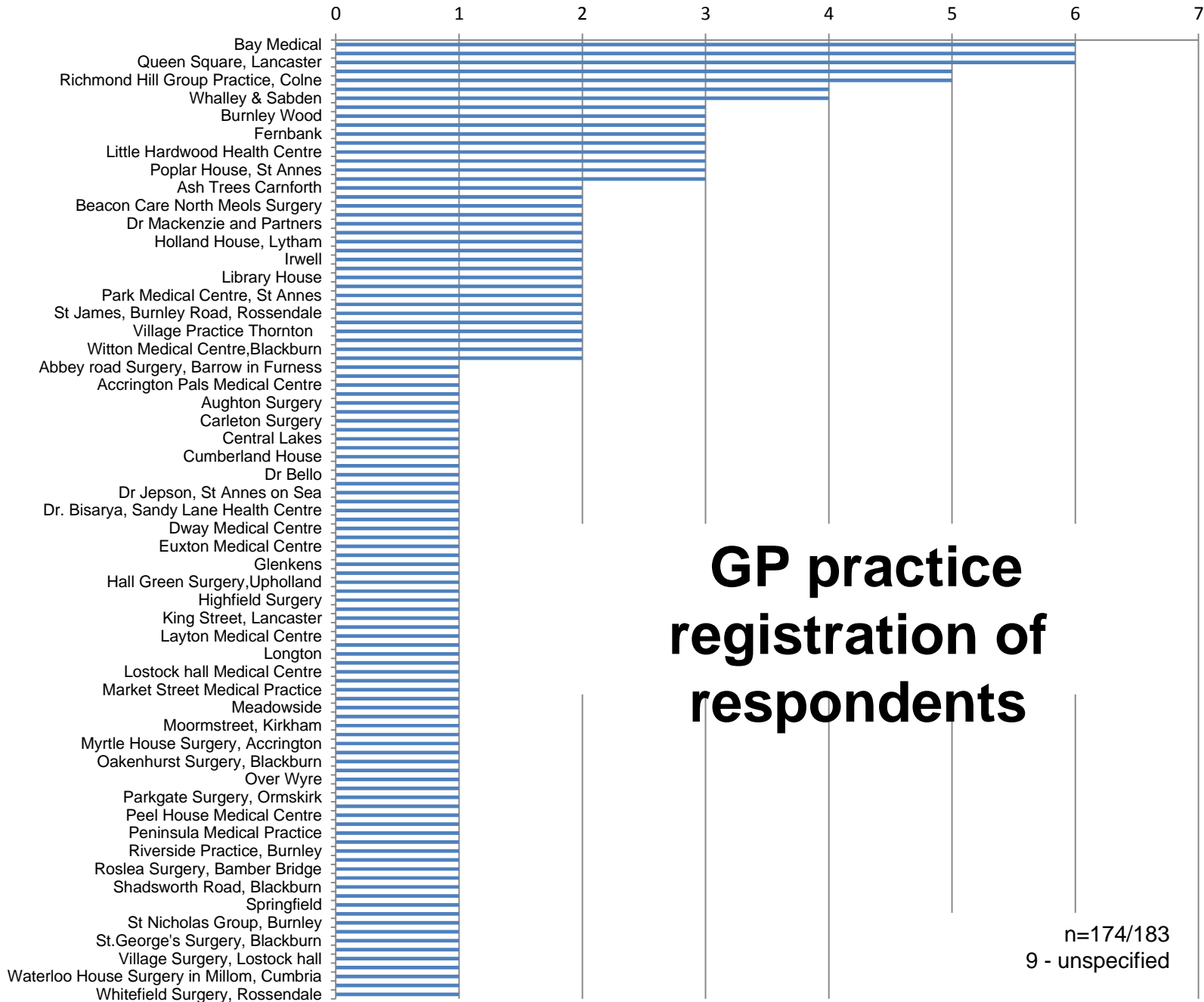

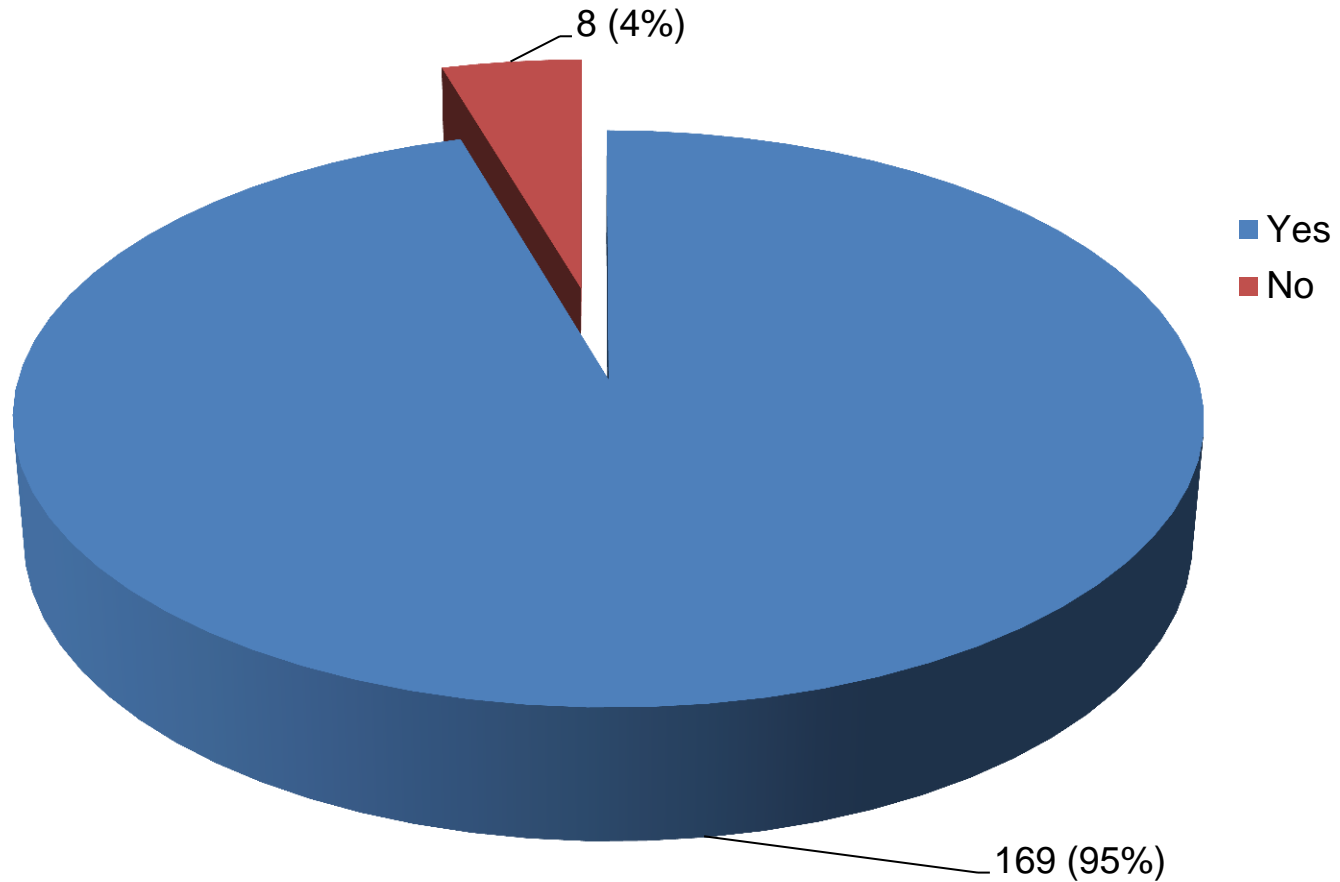
Residence of respondent

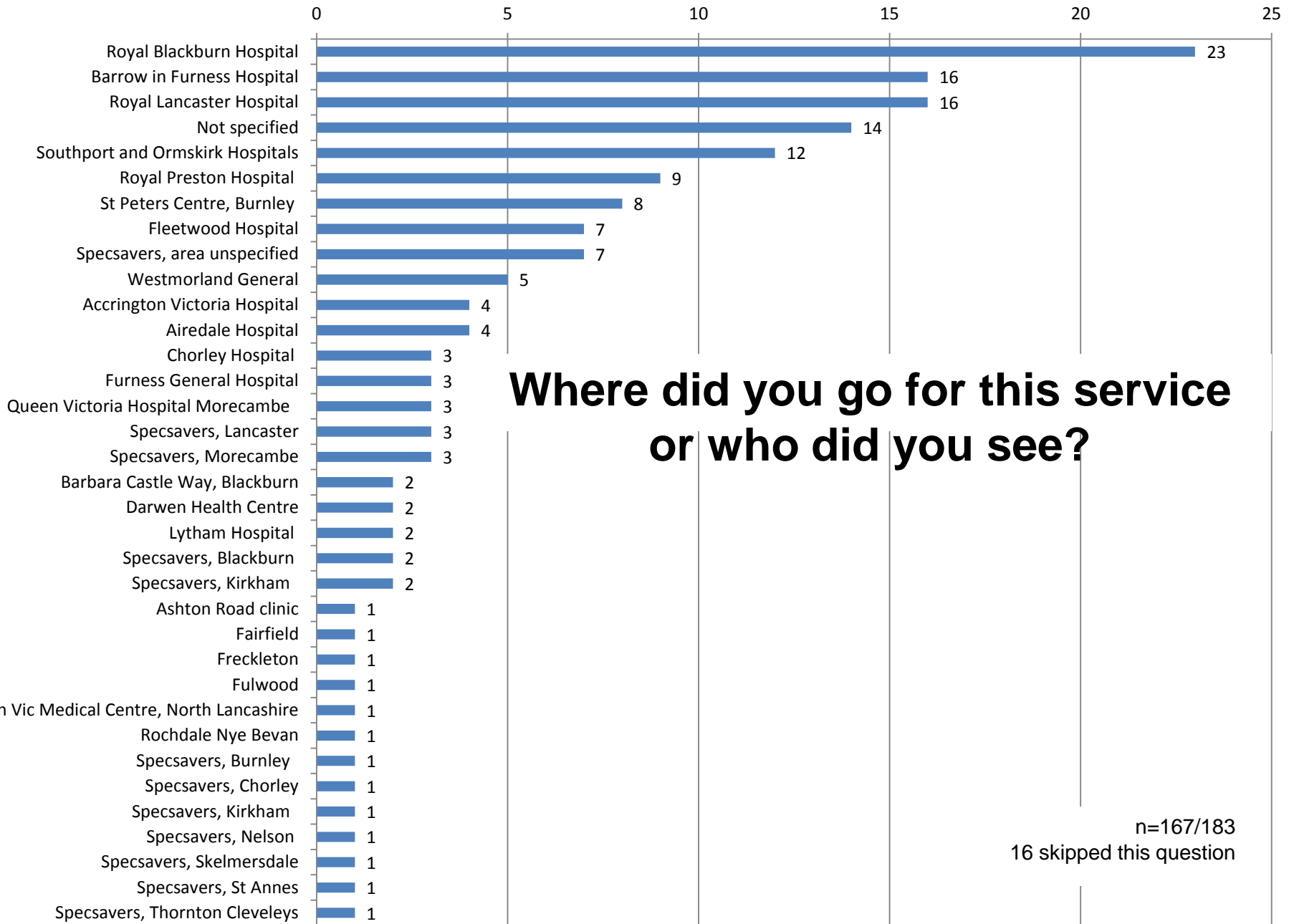


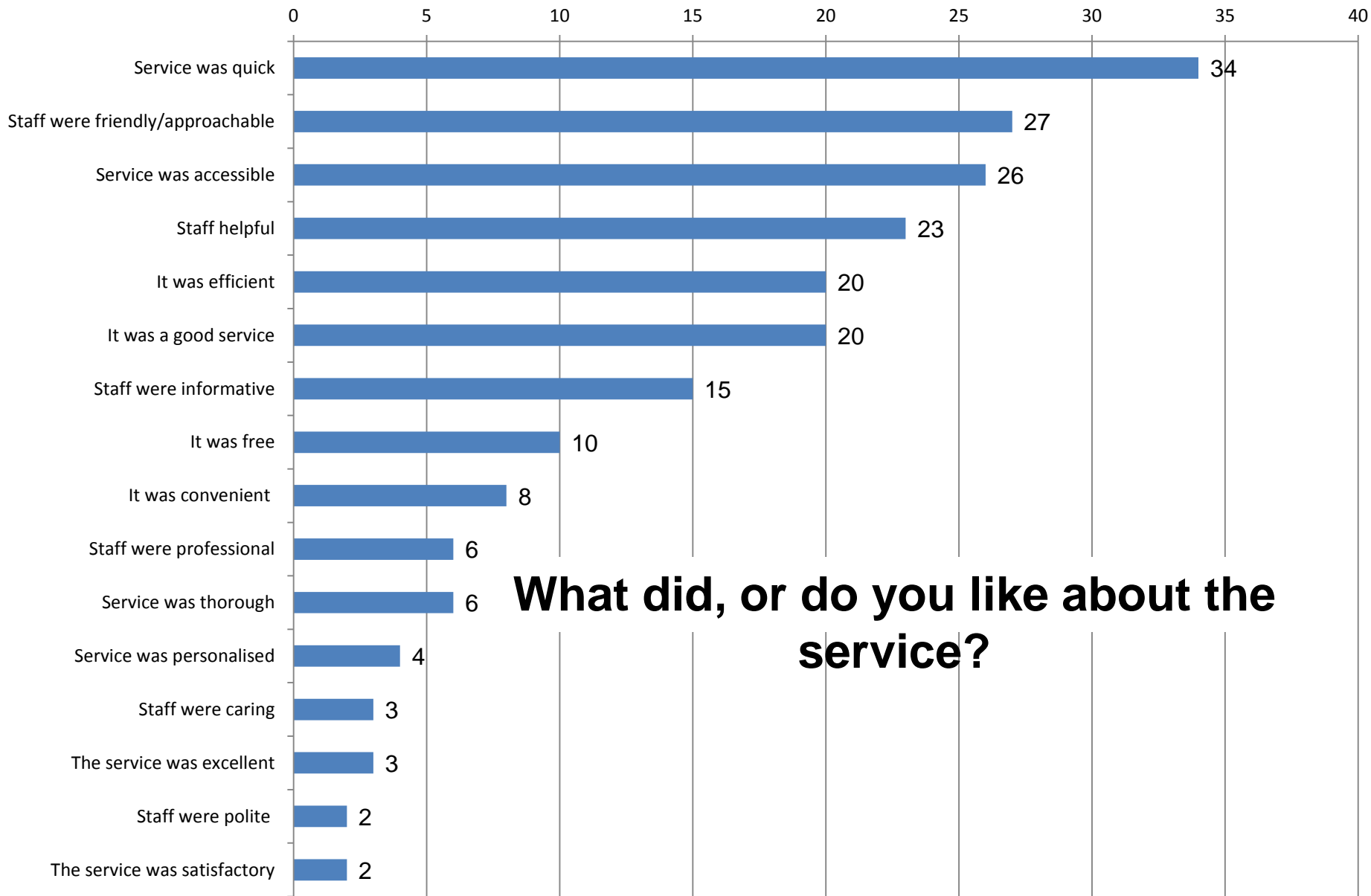
Have you used an NHS Hearing Aid Service?

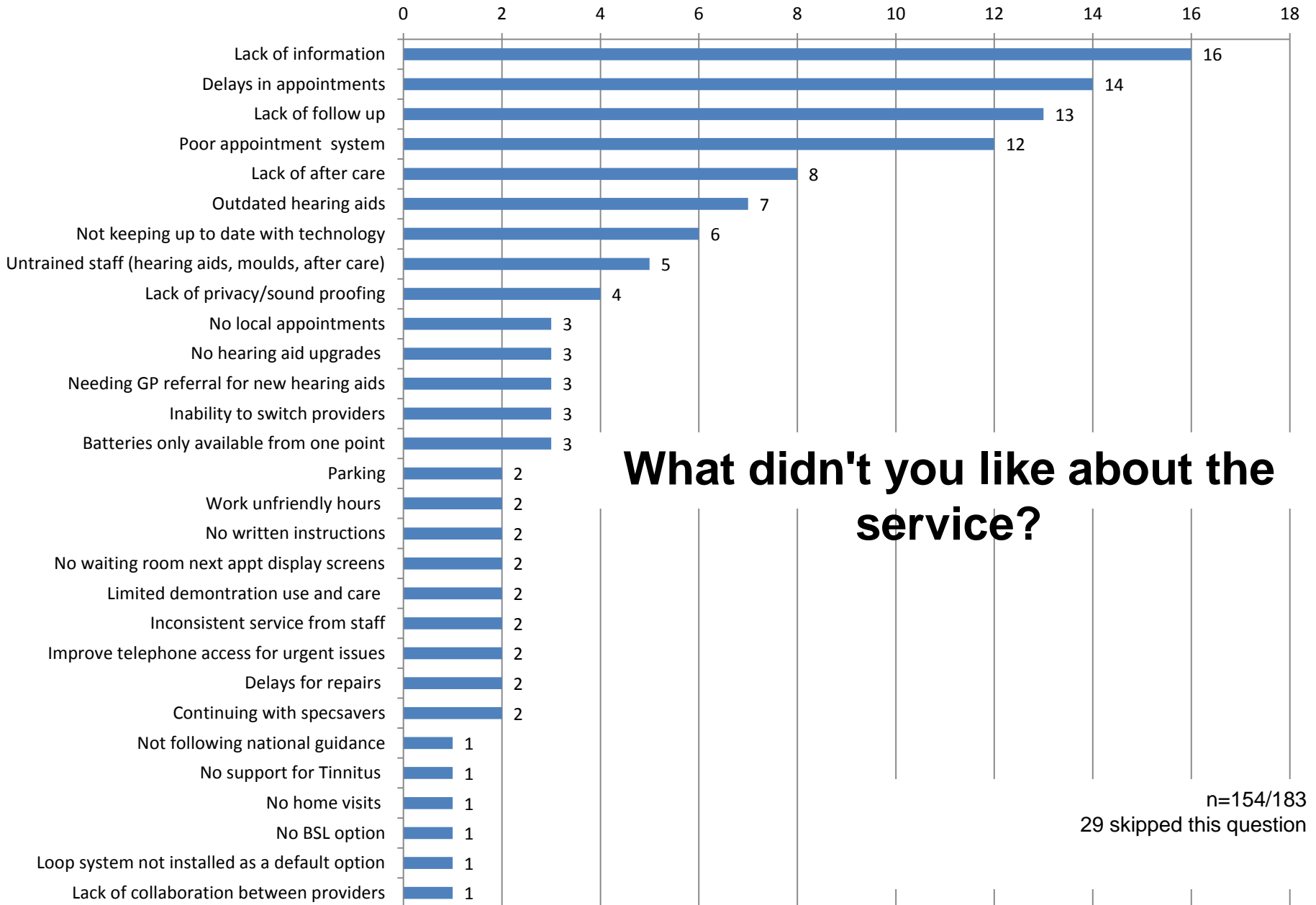

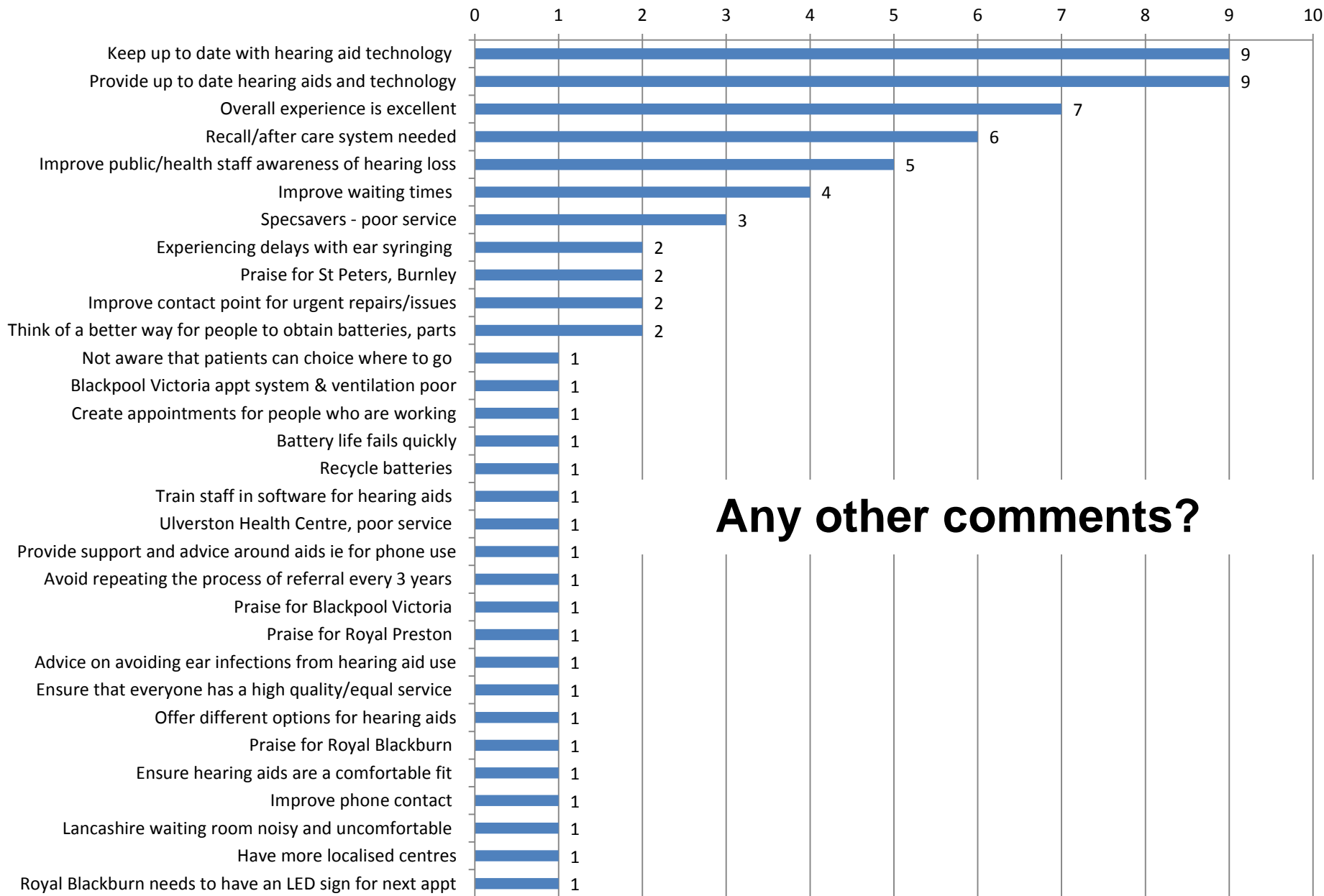
Where did you go for this service or who did you see?
